Date: April 21, 2025

Survey Summary:

Our recently completed survey among likely Republican primary voters in the Commonwealth of Kentucky reveals that Daniel Cameron is the clear front-runner in the Republican primary election for U.S. Senate. Daniel Cameron is the best known and best liked among the candidates. With the endorsement of President Donald Trump, Cameron grows his support even further among primary voters.

Thinking ahead to the 2026 Republican primary election for U.S. Senate, if the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

- Seven-in-ten Republican primary voters have a favorable view of Daniel Cameron, 71% (40% very/ 31% somewhat), only 18% say they are unfavorable towards him.
- Nearly three-in-four Republican primary voters approve of the job Daniel Cameron did as Attorney General of Kentucky, 73% (42% strongly/31% somewhat), only 12% disapprove.
- Seven-in-ten Republican primary voters identify Daniel Cameron as an ideological conservative, 69%.
- With the endorsement of President Trump, Daniel Cameron's vote-share improves to capture a majority of the vote: 53% (+9).
- Republican primary voters overwhelmingly approve of the job Donald Trump is doing as President, 87%.

Conclusion:

Daniel Cameron has earned the respect of Republican primary voters by fighting as Attorney General for conservative values alongside President Trump. As the tried-and-true Trump conservative in the Republican primary for U.S. Senate, an endorsement from President Trump would build upon Daniel Cameron's lead in this race and win the Republican nomination.

Methodology:

McLaughlin & Associates conducted a statewide survey in Kentucky among 500 likely Republican primary voters between April 13 and 15, 2025. The survey included a mix of landline phone, mobile phone, and text-to-web interviews. Interview selection was at random within predetermined election units. The accuracy of the sample of 500 likely Republican primary voters is within +/- 4.5% at a 95% confidence interval. The numbers in this presentation have been rounded and may not equal 100%.
